
APRIL MEETING - APRIL 22

TECH TOPICS SEARCH

At the March club pizza meeting, Greg Hanlin did a presentation on how to find any topic on the CORSA website. It proves to be very useful knowing there is a tool you can use to help find answers when working on your Corvair. If you are a CORSA member, you have access to every article written in the CORSA Communique at your fingertip. Greg showed us using the Tech Topics Search. He could find any articles relating to repairing, replacing, maintenance, anything that had been published and archived on the website. It is easy to find and use.

After you log in to Corvair.org, hover over Publications & Galleries and select Tech Topics


When selecting, in this case Roof Rack, the search result yielded three articles. In fig #4, it showed the title.


year and volume number, and pages the article is in. Click on the highlighted hyperlink and the actual publication will open in the next window or tab.

GEN (ALT) / FAN LIGHT STAYS ON WHILE RUNNING

Mark M posted on Corvair Center that his Gen/Fan light stayed on dimly while his newly bought 1965 140 Corvair was running. Responses to his problem included:

Poster Rex Johson; Some electronic regulators don't play nice with indicator lights.

Poster RKF; If one diode of the diode trio goes bad it can cause this. If the diode goes bad the alternator will continue to charge, but not at full potential. According to RKF the diode trio is also known as the bridge rectifier inside the alternator and can be checked with an ohm meter. He says most auto parts stores can do this.

Poster Coventure Dave says the wrong indicator bulb can cause this problem. Use a heavier filament bulb.

Mark M ended up solving his problem with a new alternator.

J & S ELECTRONICS SAFEGUARD KNOCK SENSOR

The Corvair Center Forum has had 70 discussions over time about using a knock (ping) sensor on the Corvair. As most know all newer cars use knock sensors to eliminate the "ping" that could damage the engine. When new cars want to "ping", the engine advance is retarded to eliminate the "ping" allowing the use of low octane gasoline and also to maximize power. For the most popular Corvair engine, the 110 HP, high test gas is recommended because of the engine's compression ratio. The turbo Corvair is limited to about 8 psi of boost to minimize "ping". New cars can produce twice as much or more of turbo boost. With premium gas \$.80 more per gallon, it would be nice to run 87 octane.

GM did not put a turbo charger on Corvairs with an automatic transmission because they could not eliminate the "ping" that occurred when the upshift from low into high took place with the two speed PG.

The best location for the knock sensor on the Corvair engine appears to be the top shroud bolt between cylinders 2 and 4 (first two on the left facing the front of the car. Google Safeguard Knock Sensor for more info on the unit.



TOOL BOX REFRIGERATOR


