LATE MODEL HEADLIGHT SWITCH REMOVAL

To remove the switch one needs to pull the knob and stem out of the switch. The stem is released by a hard to reach button on the top of the switch behind the dash. Here are several tips found on the Corvair Center forum.

Have small hands or maybe get a grand kid to do it.

Per CC poster Vegas Vair, remove the A pillar cover and push the button down using a screwdriver. On an A/C car remove the A/C air outlet ball and reach in for the release button.

Per CC poster Craig Nicol, remove the two bolts holding the steering column under the dash and use the seat belt through the steering wheel to hold it down to get more room to reach the button.

Per CC poster Lane 66, pull the knob all the way out and then push it back in just a little and then press the release button (Ed note: if you can reach it).

SLOW TURN SIGNAL FLASHER

Per Corvair Center poster Craig Nicol, the conventional thermal flasher that a Corvair uses is load sensitive. (Ed note: Thus, if your signal suddenly starts blinking slow you have either a front or rear bulb out. Conversely, if you should happen to pull a trailer, the extra light on the trailer will cause the signal to blink faster). In the example on CC, the Corvair owner had converted his rear backup lights to tail/stop lights upping the electrical load on the blinker causing it to blink too fast]. Craig says a solution to the fast blinking is to change the standard Corvair flasher from a 224 to a 552 if you are using the standard 1157 bulbs.
