AIRTEX ELECTRIC FUEL PUMPS

Corvair Center texter, wheels4fun, posted that he had an Airtex E8016S electric fuel pump go bad on his Corvair. That led to a lengthy discussion about the Airtex fuel pumps. The discussion centered on the pump in question probably being a Chinese knockoff since it was purchased on Amazon for only \$26. Well known Corvair mechanic, Steve Goodman, reported that he has installed a number of Airtex pumps over time and has had good luck with them. Steve mention that he buys his pumps from parts store like NAPA or Facet. The price of the Airtex pumps Steve buys is in the \$95 range. Back in 2015 Steve called Airtex and asked if one could tell the difference between a real Airtex and a knockoff. They said no.

Steve reminded all that electric pumps are intended to be fuel pushers, not fuel suckers, and for that reason they should be located low enough that the fuel will gravity to the pump. He did say that sitting seems to reduce the life of a fuel pump. The Airtex electric pump has an inlet filter that might get plugged. When another poster mentioned that the in-tank filter should stop any dirt before it gets to the pump filter, Steve responded that in his experience a lot of filters are missing or torn.

Another poster mentioned that the Airtex electric will not allow fuel to be pulled through it by the mechanical pump if one should be using the electric pump only for starting.

MECHANICAL PUMPS

During the electric fuel pump discussion, Corvair racer Mike Levine (AKA v8vair), stated that after he machined the bottom section of his mechanical pumps, he had no more issues. Other posters mentioned problems with Airtex mechanical pumps. (Ed notes: Another case of Chinese knockoffs?).

Clark's Corvair Parts just announced they have completed testing their new mechanical fuel pump. With hundreds of hours and 2000 miles of actual road test, the testing is done, and production is being finished. Their new fuel pumps should be in stock this Spring.
